DAY 1: DEPART BY BUS FROM GATEWAY CENTRE

(Route: L'Agulhas Lighthouse to Brandfontein Farmstead: 16,479km)

Date: Thursday, 14 March 2024
Time: 05:30am - departure at 06:30am
Place: The Beanery, Gateway Shopping Centre

PLEASE NOTE:

- Toilets will be open
- Do not park and leave your car at Gateway - you will only be back in Hermanus on Sunday. The end point is at Grotto Beach NOT Gateway Shopping Centre.
- Make the necessary arrangements for your car at the guesthouse or a friend's house or alternate safe parking area.

On arrival at **The Beanery, Gateway Centre**, please go to the tables to receive your emergency card and finalise your registration.

- Take your tog bag, Taxi bag and **camping chair** to the specific bus you are allocated to.
- The L2L Committee has carefully allocated everyone to a bus. This cannot be changed. You won't necessarily travel in the same bus as your friend. You will be travelling on the same bus every day. Use this opportunity to get to know the other fellow walkers, sponsors and the L2L committee members. You will be spending a lot of time with your friends.
- At The Beanery you will receive a cup of coffee, go to the toilet and meet and greet others.
- Our patron, Elnora Gillion, will welcome everyone and wish us well on the 4-day walk.
- Get into your allocated bus **WITH your backpack, which must be ready for the day (refer to the packing lists)**. Please ensure that you have enough water and food for the day. It might rain, so please bring a rain jacket or poncho.
- The buses leave promptly **at 6:30am**. It takes approximately 2 hours to get to Agulhas.



On arrival at Agulhas Lighthouse: get off the buses, receive your inspirational card for the day and gather on the lawn in front of the lighthouse. You will not have any access to your luggage.

Start the walk: L'Agulhas Lighthouse to Brandfontein Farmstead (16,479km)

- We usually walk for approximately 1½ hours before we have a comfort break.
- The leaders and sweepers are announced daily. No-one is allowed to pass the leader or fall behind the sweeper.

ACCOMMODATION

The committee will try to include everyone's accommodation requests. The accommodation lists are circulated on the buses together with maps of Die Dam - showing the location of chalets.

Please take note that accommodation is in separate houses which may have some single beds and double beds. Houses will be cleaned before you arrive in camp on Thursday.

When you arrive in camp collect your luggage from the bus. Residents from Die Dam will be available to take you to your allocated house.

- Coffee and something sweet will be available for free at the coffee station.
- The Tuckshop will be open where you can buy refreshments - this includes wine | beer | gin & tonic | small selection of sweets & chocolates. All money will go to the main beneficiary.
- We encourage everyone to use the opportunity to get to know other walkers and socialise under the tent.

DAY 2: BRANDFONTEIN FARMSTEAD TO DIE DAM: 18,262 KM

Date: Saturday, 16 March 2024

Please take money along for ice cream/cold drinks at the shop in Pearly Beach

05:30	Breakfast will be served. Pack your food for the day
06:30	Gather for roll call and thought for the day
07:00	Depart from Die Dam on foot Arrival at Pearly Beach: visit the shop for ice cream, cold drinks, etc. The buses will collect the walkers and transport back to Die Dam. Arrival at Die Dam: coffee/tea will be available at the coffee station and Tuckshop
18:00	Socializing under the tent
18:30	Announcements of the following day's program. Acknowledging the organisers at Die Dam, catering crew, tuck shop staff, bus drivers, leader
19:30	Supper - this will be a surprise



DAY 4: PEARLY BEACH TO DANGER POINT LIGHTHOUSE, GANSBAAI: 26.664KM

Date: Sunday, 17 March 2024

05:30	Breakfast will be served. Pack your food for the day
06:30	All luggage must be at the buses and bungalows swept and cleaned. Pack your official L2L T-shirt and official buff or wear it for the day. You will wear these on arrival at Danger Point Lighthouse.
07:00	Roll Call and thought for the day
07:30	Depart from Die Dam by Bus Lunch stop will be in Kleinbaai
15:15 - 15:30	Arrival at Danger Point Lighthouse The lighthouse grounds are open and a special surprise awaits. We will gather for the official photo and handing out of medals, by the sponsor.
16:00 - 16:15	Departure by bus to Grotto
17:30 - 18:00	Arrival at Grotto and walk as a group on the beach to the area in front of Dutchies, where we will be met by family, friends, sponsors, the media and dignitaries
18:00	Collect your luggage at the buses. Please do not make any travel plans before being collected from Grotto Beach at 18.00. You must also plan on how to get from Grotto to where you are planning to stay the evening or where your car is parked.
